Things at school have really moved on and as of next week all of the Foundation and year 1 children will be back. To accommodate this and the growing number of Key Workers' children some children will move class bubbles next week. This is in line with Public Health guidance.

Class 1 – All **Foundation** children – 8:45 – 2:45 car park drop off and pick up

Class 2 – All **Year 1** children – 8:30 – 3:00 car park drop off and pick up

Class 3 – Key Worker children in **years 2 and 3** - 8:30 – 3:00 Lane gates drop off and pick up

Class 4 – Key Worker children in **years 4, 5 and 6** - 8:30 – 3:00 lane gates drop off and pick up

The staff leading the bubbles will remain unchanged.

Staff and I are very much looking forward to having all the children back in September. It will feel like we are getting closer to normal. We are waiting for the government guidance to before we can fully plan. Staff, governors and I will do all we can to keep you informed.
