Covid secure: Please take care to maintain a social distance at the beginning and end of the school day. As of today there is no indication for Devon schools that half term will be extended. Virtual Parent / Teacher Consultations: Thanks to all who have made the time and used Teams to talk to your child's class teacher as we have moved online for years 1 to 6. So far the technology has mostly worked, Class 2 had a camera issue and Class 4 no sound, but these were quickly resolved.
