<u>Covid secure:</u> Although still low compared to national rates the number of Covid 19 cases in North Devon has increased. Please be assured that staff governors and I are taking the necessary actions in line with our risk assessment, DfE and Public Health guidance. Cones will stay in the lane for Class 3 and 4 parents to have space to be socially distanced.

<u>Virtual Parent / Teacher Consultations:</u> Thank you to everyone who responded to the Forms survey. You should receive your appointment to speak with your child's teacher by email. For years 1 to 6 it will be an invitation to an online Teams meeting. To manage staff work load and well-being we are not offering late appointments. It is a virtual system for a 10 minute meeting, which you can take wherever you are even if you are still at work! I hope you will be able to take a 10 minute break to talk about your child's progress. Within the email you will find the time slot for your 10 minute session. If you have not used Teams before please test the link in the email (Join Microsoft Teams Meeting) you will be given the option to view in your internet browser, use the app if you have it or download it. Please join the meeting a few minutes before your time; you will then be waiting in the virtual lobby for the class teacher to admit you. Once your meeting has finished please leave the call to allow the next parent their time. Emails will have been sent to the address you gave in the Forms survey. Please be patient with us as we try this system out. If you cannot see your time slot please email your class teacher. If opening on a phone, the time slots may not be obvious!

<u>Dressed for all weather:</u> Please ensure your child is dressed for all types of weather. I have been very pleased to find that jumpers and coats have names in and that property is being returned to children. As part of our Covid 19 risk assessment we are keeping classroom doors and windows open to give a good flow of fresh air. Please make sure your child is warmly dressed for class. Ideally they need several thin layers; vest (or another t-shirt), school t-shirt and sweatshirt or fleece.
