Traffic – To help with running three different gates for children to get into and out of school please make sure you park in the right place. Class 1 parents use the Community Hall car park (cars remain in car park until 8:30am); Class 2 parents park in the lane below the black gate entrance. Class 3 and 4 parents park above the black gates in the lane. Please take extra care in the darker mornings and afternoons as people are walking in the lanes.

Car Park Gate: A very speedy replacement – thank you to Ben Sloggie and John Turner for installing a new post and getting the gate working again for Monday morning. Please note the rope to hold the gate back is for staff use only.

Covid secure: Please take care to maintain a social distance at the beginning and end of the school day.

Dear Parents/guardians,

Your child is due to be in Reception to Year 6 from September 2020 and they are therefore eligible for a Free Nasal Childhood Flu Vaccination.

It is anticipated that this will be delivered in schools between October 2020 to December 2020, this will be administered adhering to all up to date Infection Control, PPE and social distancing guidance at the time.

Flu vaccination is one of the most effective interventions we have to reduce pressure on the health and social care system which is going to be more important than ever this year. For this reason, it is essential we deliver the vaccine to as many children as possible to prevent the spread of infection to those most at risk in society.

In light of the above we are expecting demand to be high and therefore we urge you to follow the below link to consent to your child's vaccination now. Even if you do not want your child to receive this vaccination, please complete the consent form stating "no" consent. You will also find answers to your FAQ's on this link.
