

Dear Parent / Carer

With all the children back learning in class, it has been interesting to deal with the usual round of behaviours and disagreements. It is very much part of our work to enable children to talk about their feelings and to help them through the challenges we all face. All staff are committed to getting children into the right emotional state to learn and are happy to spend time talking issues through. We have Mrs Williamson and Mrs Green running Thrive sessions, with Mrs Bennett and Mrs Sanders trained in a similar programme (Boxall Profile.)

With children spending more time online, we have had disagreements spill over into school. Staff and I wish to work with parents to support their children to game and chat safely and I have had great conversations with parents who are closely supervising children's interactions online. I know children want to play games which are rated as unsuitable for primary ages (PEGI 12 and higher) and advise parents to consider close monitoring of screen activities. There is much advice on the sites shared in the online safety briefing from earlier this year.

We remain operating the school in class bubbles and the drop off and pick arrangements are as they were in December. Class 1 to use car park, Class 2 to use the garden gate and Classes 3 and 4 the gate in the lane. As before, older children can come in through the younger child's gate. Parents will need to remain distanced at each gate and will be expected to leave straight away after drop off and pick up. Parents using the car park for Class 1's gate must wait until 8:30am before leaving.

Staff News – Mrs Lethaby, our SENDCo will be leaving Marwood at Easter. Her last day is Tuesday 30th March. On behalf of all I want to thank her for her amazing work and wish her the best for her future. I am pleased to say that Jennie Cousins will be joining us in this role after Easter.
