Dear Parent / Carer

Covid 19 Road Map – very little will change at school in terms of our Covid Secure actions from Monday 17<sup>th</sup> May. All bubbles, three different entrances, hygiene, distancing and hand washing remain in place. We are not yet able to invite parents onto the site. Staff are working to enhance the children's schooling as much as possible and greatly appreciate all the work that parents are doing at home with reading and homework. You will see from the 'save the dates' above that we are planning summer events but they can only take place if schools' guidance after 21<sup>st</sup> June allows.

Residential trips for Classes 3 and 4. We have not had these trips since 2019 due to lockdowns and restrictions. We are planning two such trips in the next school year. Parents of children in current years 4 and 5 have been sent a Forms survey as we hope to run a 2 night Class 4 trip in October; the response so far is very positive. All being well we will organise a Class 3 residential for the Summer Term 2022.
