

Dear Parent / Carer

Covid 19 changes: The government has issued Step 4 guidance for parents of school age children, it can be found <u>here</u>. It is plain that cases in North Devon are increasing, with many local schools impacted.

At Marwood School we are going to keep the children in their class bubbles next week to reduce any additional contacts. Please note that for any cases from Monday 19th July schools no longer have the responsibility for telling contacts to isolate if there is a confirmed Covid case. Following Devon Public Health and DCC Health and Safety instructions, for any Covid cases at school next week, we will tell the affected bubble to stay at home and access online learning. Please contact me if you need further information.

If a child or family member has Covid 19 symptoms they must go for a PCR test and the other family members must isolate until the result is known and then take the necessary actions.

Reports – all children will bring home their annual school report on Monday next week. Please note that this year we have followed DfE guidance and the format is shorter. Please take time to share it with your child and staff and I would really appreciate it if you would complete the feedback slip.

As we build back stronger after the Covid interruptions to learning, we are making some changes in Class 1. The year 1 children in Classes 1 and 2 will be taught together for English, maths and PE in Class 2. Some of the year 1 children will then return to Class 1 for the other curriculum subjects.

Parents of our year 6 are invited to an outdoor leavers' assembly on Friday 23rd July at 2:15pm. Details have been sent via email.

Staffing changes – I am pleased to announce that Mrs Helen Jones will be teaching in Class 3 two days a week from September with Mrs Mannell teaching three days.



We are fortunate to be welcoming author, poet and story teller, Chitra Soundar, into school in the new school year on Tuesday October 5th.



Chitra Soundar is an Indian-born British writer, storyteller and author of children's books, based in London. Chitra grew up on a wholesome diet of stories from Indian myths, epics and folklore. She's funny with friends, plays pranks at work and puts a lot of jokes into her books that are usually set in India or in Indian homes. She is keen to create stories with Asian themes and protagonists that have broad appeal to children from all backgrounds.

Chitra has been a teacher, programmer and other complicated jobs that grownups do in an office. She has written picture books, stories for emerging readers, poetry and junior fiction. She occasionally writes some poems too. Chitra's picture

books, especially The Farmer Falgu series have been translated into French, German, Thai, Japanese and American English and are quite popular amongst children. In the UK, Chitra is published by Walker Books, Otter-Barry Books, Lantana Publishing, Bloomsbury amongst others. She has over 30 books in print worldwide. In 2018, A Jar of Pickles and a Pinch of Justice won the Eugenie Summerfield Children's Book Prize.
