## Covid 19.

Everyone is grateful for the effort to follow the guidance to reduce the spread of Covid 19. Staff will call parents to collect their child and have them PCR tested if we see any of the notifiable symptoms during the school day. We cannot diagnose a whether a cough is 'just a cough'. The Barnstaple Walk In PCR test centre is returning results very quickly. The guidance is that well children should attend school and do not need to isolate unless they have a positive PCR result. UPDATE on LFD – primary age children without symptoms who are waiting for a PCR test result to come back can take a Lateral Flow Device (LFD) test. An example is if the PCR test was taken in an afternoon as a contact and the result had not come back before school the next day a LFD could be used. If the LFD is negative the child can come to school. If the child has symptoms they must isolate until the PCR result is known. Unfortunately primary schools cannot supply LFD tests for children.

<u>Children in Need</u> – Thank you to all who generously made donations to today's BBC Children in Need Appeal. £143.56 has been collected. Children enjoyed wearing their own clothes, eating cookies and dancing at break time.
