

Dear Parent / Carer

Covid 19. As of today there are three confirmed cases in Class 3 and two in Class 4.

Everyone is grateful for the effort to follow the guidance to reduce the spread of Covid 19. Staff will call parents to collect their child and have them PCR tested if we see any of the notifiable symptoms during the school day. We cannot diagnose a whether a cough is 'just a cough'. The Barnstaple Walk In PCR test centre is returning results very quickly. The guidance is that well children should attend school and do not need to isolate unless they have a positive PCR result. We are keeping our Covid Secure measures in place; ventilation, cleaning, handwashing and sanitising. If your child has a new cough and / or a high temperature and / or loss of smell / taste – the Covid 19 symptoms - they need a PCR test not a LFD.

UPDATE on LFD – primary age children without symptoms who are waiting for a PCR test result to come back can take a Lateral Flow Device (LFD) test. An example is if the PCR test was taken in an afternoon as a contact and the result had not come back before school the next day a LFD could be used. If the LFD is negative the child can come to school. If the child has symptoms they must isolate until the PCR result is known. Unfortunately primary schools cannot supply LFD tests for children.

<u>School Closure for Queen's Jubilee</u> – Governors have set the date as Monday 6<sup>th</sup> June 2022 - Marwood School will be closed on this day.

<u>Christmas performances:</u> Each class is planning to present a performance in December. Due to Covid 19 cases increasing we are not inviting families onsite. I am going to record each performance (music or play) and host recordings on the Marwood YouTube. Please look out for details in the final week of term

<u>Christmas Events</u> – Although we cannot invite parents onsite we are going ahead with a children's Christmas Fair on Friday 10<sup>th</sup> December 1:15 – 3:00. Class 4 children are organising 11 games and activities for the rest of the school. Each class will have a time slot to go around and try them out, children will be able to vote for their favourite. The MSA are going to organise refreshments and we are asking for a £2 donation per child to take part. This will cover all games and refreshments. Children can bring money in on Friday 10<sup>th</sup>.

### **Severe Weather Policy - November 2021**

Dear Parent / Carer

Following the advice of Devon Local Authority, Marwood School will endeavour to remain open during periods of severe weather; usually ice or snow.

### **Arrangements for School Closure**

Either the headteacher or the Chair of Governors will make a decision to close the school based on the safety of children, parents and staff. We will take advice from the local police regarding road conditions and the Met Office website for weather updates. The decision will be made as early as possible, being aware that conditions can change quickly. If there is significant snow A&B Contractors will be used to clear snow and salt the lanes from Crocker's Bridge, past school, over the crossroads and back down North Lane to the Milltown / Ilfracombe road. An update will be posted on the school website if this has taken place.

### **Contingency Plan for Learning**

Work for children is available on the school website under each class curriculum tab.

Should severe weather occur once school has already started and the school needs to close, parents will be contacted and children will be looked after until they can be picked up.

### School Open - Delayed Journeys

The local lane network leading to the school is not on any of the council's gritting routes and icy conditions can make the hills leading to and from school difficult. If the lanes are icy at 8.30 a.m. and the school is open you can bring your children to school later in the morning once the ice has had chance to melt.

Parents and children need to take care on the paths on the school site. Rock salt is applied when it is icy, however it cannot be guaranteed that every patch of ice will have melted.





## MARWOOD CHRISTMAS FAIR




Saturday 4<sup>th</sup> December 2021 2 -4 pm in Marwood Church
