

Dear Parent / Carer

Since the Covid 19 Pandemic began everyone at Marwood School has worked hard to educate and support children; parents and family doing home learning; staff and governors making plans and risk assessments and the children themselves being amazing with great effort and attitude. Your support is much appreciated.

This week has seen an increased number of children off and I am grateful to the families in Classes 3 and 4 who have been daily LFD testing. Classes 3 and 4 are eating lunch in their classrooms and there are no assemblies. Next week we are looking forward to welcoming many children who were isolating back. People can leave isolation if from day 5 they have two negative LFD tests a day apart. Please see the guide on the right.

Once the 10 day isolation period is complete there is no need for further testing and people can leave isolation unless they still have a high temperature.
