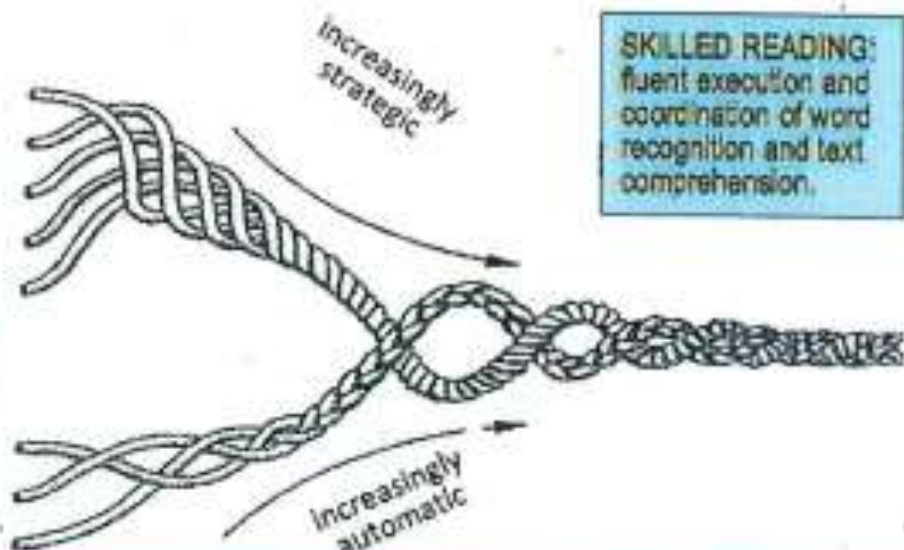
Scarborough's Reading Rope (2001)

Reading is a multifaceted skill, gradually acquired over years of instruction and practice.

Decode Infer Predict Clarify Question Summarise Discuss Enjoy

Reading Strategies

Sounding out phonemes

Use your finger to point to the words

Look at the picture

Re-read

Read-on a little and come back

Ask questions

Answer questions

Re-read whole book

Listen to how I read this

Recall parts or summarise book

Focus on specific words – checking understanding, meaning, synonym, looking up...

Talk about the book – questions, predictions, cover/blurb, recall, characters, setting, enjoyment

Marwood School has opportunities for new Meal Time Assistants (MTAs). We are looking for caring people who can interact with the children and undertake the responsibility of supervising and ensuring the safety of the children at lunchtimes. The timing is one hour a day, 12:00 – 1:00. An extra half hour is also available to take on a Covid secure cleaning role 11:30-12:00.

Days available are Wednesday, Thursday Friday (One person could work 3 days or 3 people could work one day each; or other combinations.)

The main duties are:

- To assist with the well-being of pupils during lunchtime;
- To support the supervision of children during lunch and play, using your initiative to ensure caring quality provision is continuously made;
- To co-ordinate play for pupils;
- To clean down and pack away the tables and benches.

Experience of working with children is not essential, just the passion to help improve the life chances of children within a school environment whilst being prepared to work inside and outside (in all weathers.)

Marwood is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people, and expect all staff and volunteers to share this commitment. A DBS disclosure is required for this post as is induction to the school's procedures.
