Parent Consultations

Class 3 Residential – March 2023.

All parents should now have received an email detailing the dates and instalments for the class 3 residential to Beam House in March 2023. Please feel free to get in touch should you have any questions.

Covid 19 – Regular hand washing, hygiene and ventilation will remain in place this winter. Please remember that the Covid symptoms list [What to do if you have coronavirus \(COVID-19\) or symptoms of COVID-19 - NHS \(www.nhs.uk\)](https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/symptoms/coronavirus-in-children/). <https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/symptoms/coronavirus-in-children/> is much expanded and we request that you keep your child off school for three days and that they return once well and free of a high temperature. Public Health advice is that for other illnesses please keep your child off school until they are well enough to return. For sickness / diarrhoea children can return to school 48 hours after they were last unwell.

Marwood School Association - MSA (the parents and friends group) has rearranged its AGM. It will now be on 3rd October the Community Hall, starting at 7:00pm. This group has raised £1000s over the years to benefit the school, all are welcome and it would be great to see new parents.

Traffic and parking– Please take care of pedestrians in the lanes. Class 1 Parents using the car park **must remain in the car park until 8:30** to prevent congestion in the access lane. Springfield breakfast and afterschool club need to park next to the container.

Opportunities at school – paid and voluntary.

The children and staff would really appreciate adults to help at lunchtimes between 12:00 and 1:00– with training and a DBS check. If you can offer one or more days please contact the school office, this can be a paid or voluntary role.

Required: Meal Time Assistant(s) Days to suit.

Marwood School has opportunities for new Meal Time Assistants (MTAs). We are looking for caring people who can interact with the children and undertake the responsibility of supervising and ensuring the safety of the children at lunchtimes. The timing is one hour a day, 12:00 – 1:00. An extra half hour is also available to take on a Covid secure cleaning role 11:30-12:00.

Days are available to suit (One person could work 5 days or 5 people could work one day each; or other combinations.)

The main duties are:









- To assist with the well-being of pupils during lunchtime;
- To support the supervision of children during lunch and play, using your initiative to ensure caring quality provision is continuously made;
- To co-ordinate play for pupils;
- To clean down and pack away the tables and benches.

Experience of working with children is not essential, just the passion to help improve the life chances of children within a school environment whilst being prepared to work inside and outside (in all weathers.) Marwood is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and young people, and expect all staff and volunteers to share this commitment. A DBS disclosure is required for this post as is induction to the school's procedures.
