Class 4 Badminton Club Wednesdays 3:00 – 4:00 – I will run a Class 4 club after school on Wednesdays (starting from the 9th November)– there is no charge and parents can sign their children up on school gateway. Please be aware that if I am away from school on a Wednesday the club will not run and I will give as much notice as possible.

Marwood School Association – The new committee are working incredibly hard to arrange the upcoming activities. The first event is Friday 21st October with Cookie Day and dress up. Parents have been sent the cookie day information, please be assured that everyone will receive a cookie and we will give families the chance to pay later. Dressing up - some children will want to wear spooky costumes; others their own clothes and some will be happy in their uniform.

Parking and Class 2 school access – All parents' vehicles should park on the left hand side of the lane going up hill, taking care not to block our neighbours' access. Children for Class 2 can use the main entrance in the lane or come in via the car park if they have a Class 1 brother or sister. The garden gate will be used for collection at the end of the school day.
