Safer Internet message

I hope that many of you were able to join the '2 Johns' online safety session for parents last Wednesday evening. If you were not able to join a recording will be available and I will send the link as soon as possible. Marwood staff had a session the Johns on Tuesday and it has made us realise the importance of open communication with children when they come across something – it is vital that children can talk to an adult about issues they come across online without the child being blamed or having their access completely removed.

Next week we will be joining schools and youth organisations across the UK in celebrating Safer Internet Day 2023.

Safer Internet Day is a global campaign to promote the safe and responsible use of technology, which calls on children and young people, parents, carers, teachers, social workers, law enforcement, companies, policymakers and more, to help to create a better internet. Using the internet safely and positively is a key message that we promote in school/our group/our club, and celebrating Safer Internet Day is a great opportunity for us to re-emphasise the online safety messages we deliver throughout the year.
