Mrs Cousins Charity Christmas Cards

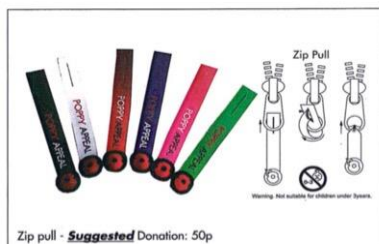
Charity Cards designed by Mrs Cousins for Chemo Hero, are now available for just £5 for a pack of 6 different designs.
